- Furniture - it doesn't sell

- Encyclopedias, magazines, or textbooks
- Videotapes or cassettes
- Large pieces of exercise equipment, e.g. exercise bikes, etc
- Live plants
- Building supplies, e.g. shutters, light fixtures
- Liquids of any kind (cosmetics, paint, etc.)
